### *NOSE*

*Bright juniper up front, backed up by sweet herbal notes*

### *PALATE*

*Bold juniper in abundance, sweet floral spice, pine, pepper and citrus*

### *FINISH*

*Long and dry with peppery warmth and lasting flavours of lemon and juniper*

### *THE IDEAL SERVE*

*Perfect for the La Zouch Martini*

*Half fill a mixing glass with ice, Chill a Martini glass with water and ice, Strain the excess from the mixing glass using a strainer.*

*50mls of Burleighs Export Strength Gin,*

*10mls of Noilly Pratt Vermouth*

*2 dashes of Angostura Orange Bitters. Stir briskly. Empty the glass, of water*

*Pour into the chilled glass using the strainer, garnish with lemon rind. Enjoy*
