### Tasting Note:

*Côte de Beaune-Villages 2016 is full of intense red fruit and liquorice aromas. The wine has lots of character with more savoury, undergrowth notes beginning to come through.*

### Winery information:

*The Côte de Beaune-Villages appellation is applied exclusively to red wines from 16 communes in the Côte de Beaune including Saint-Aubin, Pernand-Vergelesses and Auxey-Duresses. Maison Louis Latour carefully selects the grapes that are most representative of the appellation to produce this wine.*

*The soil in the vineyards of Cote de Beaune is of clay and limestone, producing wines that combine finesse, aromatic richness and structure.*

*The average age of the vines are 25 years with an average yield of 50 hl/ha.*

*Harvested by hand.*

### Vinification:

*Maison Louis Latour has always been careful to select those wines vinified in a traditional manner.*

*Fermentation takes place in traditional in open vats. Ageing takes 10 to 12 months in stainless steel vats.*

*Cellaring Potential 3 - 5 years*

*Serving temperature 14 - 15°*

*Grilled meat - charcuterie - meat terrine – cheese*
